# Race and Rally

- Full Course Offshore – requires life raft
  - Race includes being more than 10NM offshore
- Junior Offshore
  - Coastal passage race within 10NM of the shore
- Cruising Rally
  - Coastal passage rally within 10NM of the shore
- All the above...
  - Start at DOSC
  - Finish at Royal Yacht Club of Ras Al Khaimah

## Entry Docs

- Boat Registration, Skipper Licence, Vessel LOA/Beam, Shore Power Required?
- Copy of valid UAE navigation permit (for foreign flagged boats)
- Also, numbers for buffet - whether crew or anyone joining your group by road.
- To be consolidated by DOSC and sent to RYCRAK by Thursday 28<sup>th</sup> March just after 0800hrs.

## Crew Docs

- Final crew list and EID for all crew members. (Passport and visa stamp for non-residents).
- To be consolidated by DOSC and sent to RYCRAK.
- This will also be used for a group coastguard permit – it is important that the number of crew on your permit matches the number of people on your boat and EIDs are provided for all.

# Group CG Permit

For both the race and rally group. DOSC will get a group coastguard permit and get this stamped from the CG.

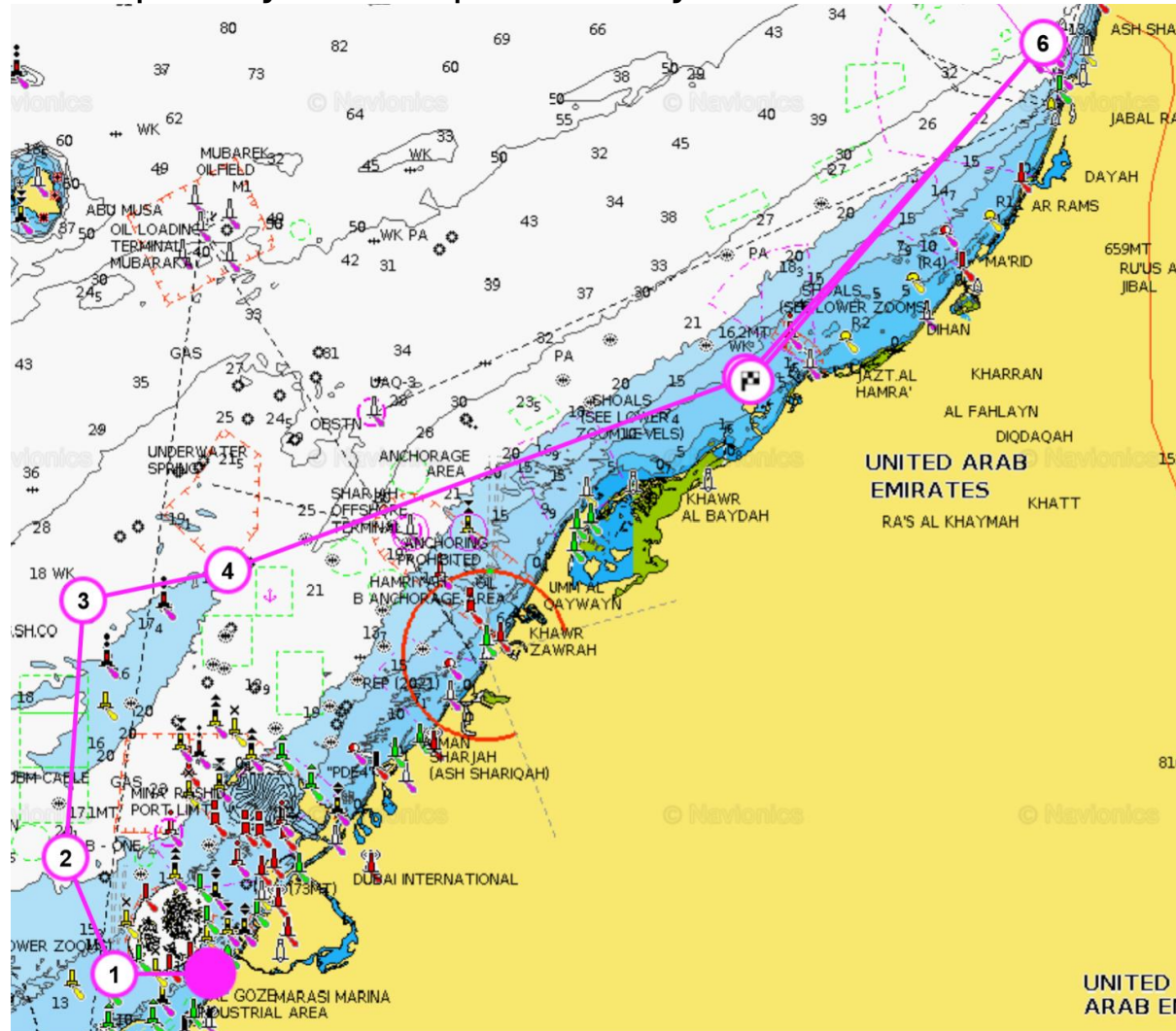
It is each boats responsibility to check they are on this permit with the correct crew number before departure.

If your crew number changes after the group permit is issued or you are missing from it, you must get your own permit.

Each boat may collect a hard copy of the respective group sign out from DOSC reception prior to departure. (I will get these left at DOSC security for the Rally group).

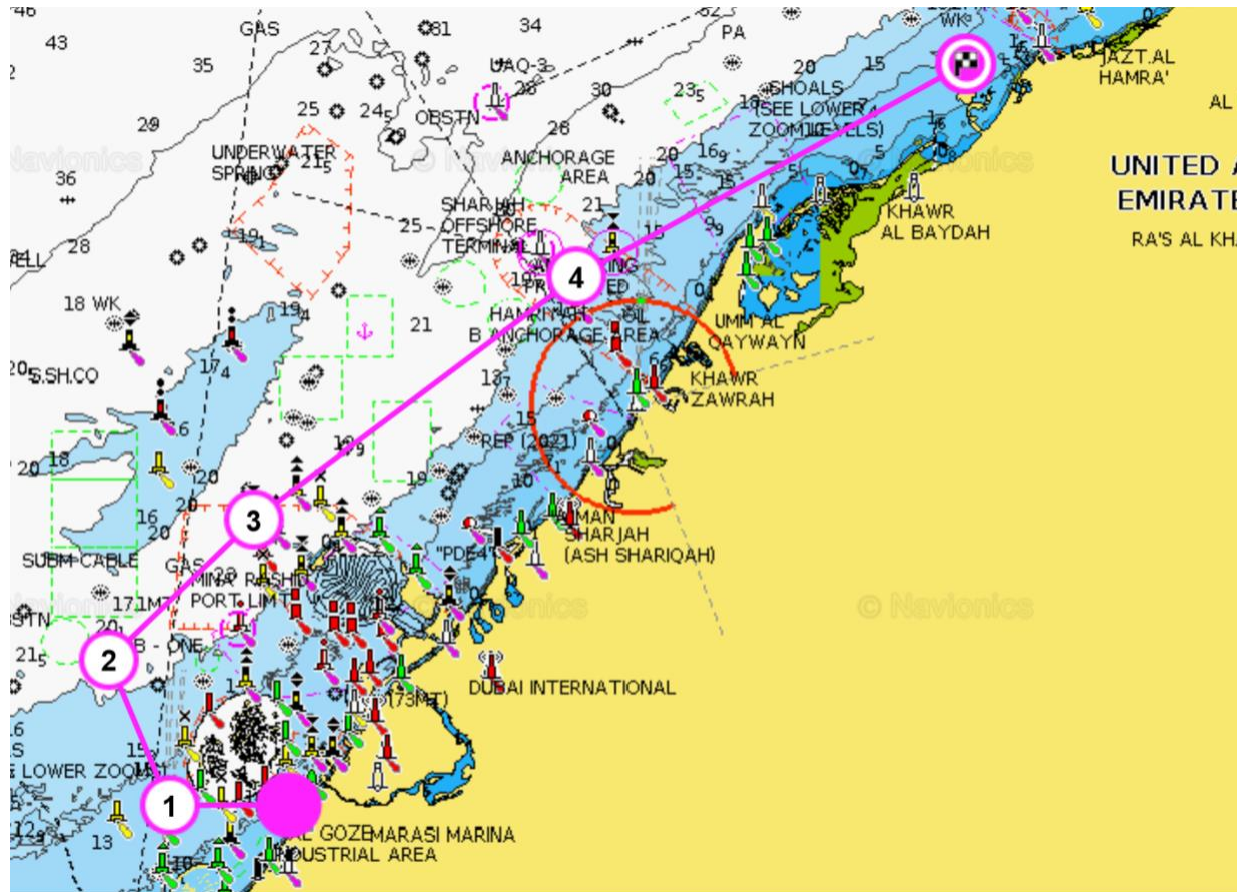
# Full Course – Approx. 110 NM

Committee Boat Start between boat and pin – Thanks Mikey.

Both full and junior start together.

Warning signal at 1655hrs. Start at 1700hrs.

VHF 08

# Finish

The finish will be near the yellow special purpose buoy R3 which SHOULD be lit.

The buoy will serve as an ODM (outer distance mark) and you must finish between the mark and the land.

Finish time should be taken when you cross the specified latitude (IE N 55°42.500').

Finish time should be emailed to [sailingadmin@doscuae.com](mailto:sailingadmin@doscuae.com) within 1 hour of your finish with a photo of your GPS position and time in the HH:MM:SS format.

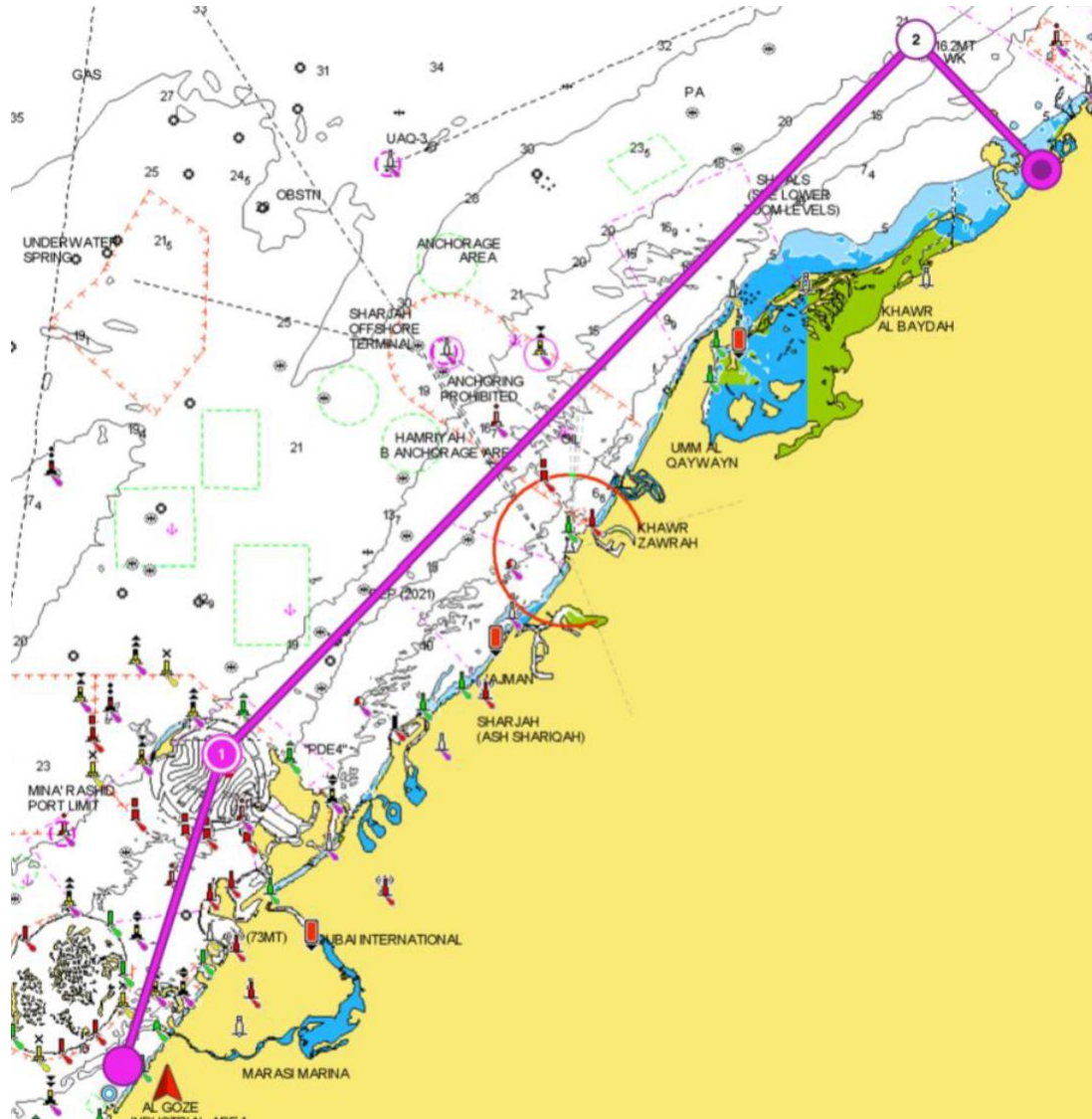


N-S will denote crossing this line from North to South.

# Rally – Approx 50NM



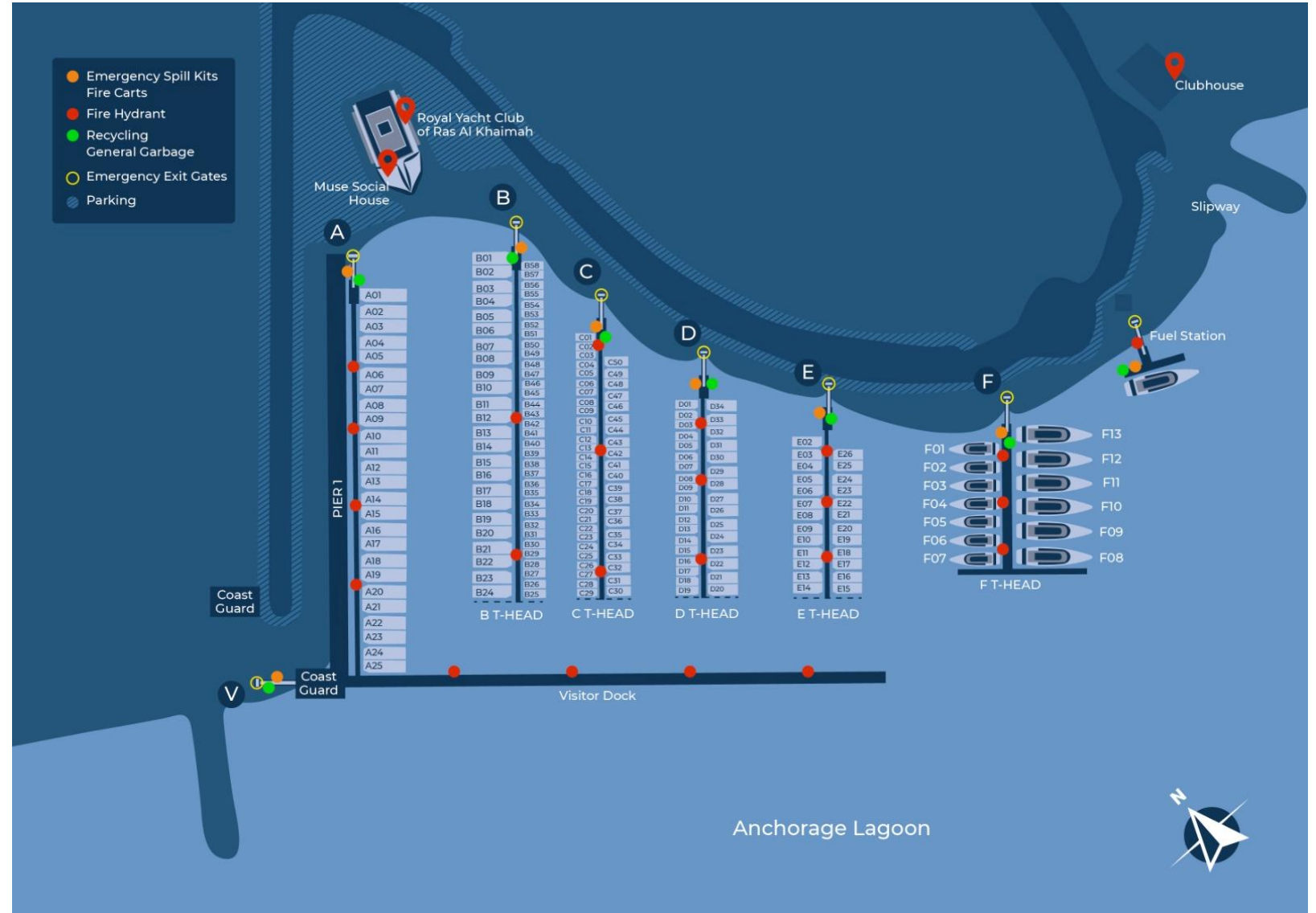
# Approach to RYCRAK
