Finish

This race is scheduled to finish at a fixed finish line in the location previously published. A finish boat displaying a blue flag may be present to form the finish line.

If no finish boat is on station, competitors shall self-declare their finishing time.

- Competitors must take their own finish time using GPS time.
- Times must be submitted to sailingadmin@doscuae.com within 30 minutes of finishing.
- Please report your time in the HH:MM:SS format.

The finish line extends 100m (0.05 NM) from “FINISH” coordinates on a bearing of 110°, and boats shall finish within this distance.
